What is a Champion?

As a Gambling Related Harms Champion, you will be a safe point of contact within your organisation, offering initial support and signposting colleagues or anyone affected by gambling-related harms to appropriate services.



What will we need from you?

- **Minimal time commitment:** fits alongside your existing role.
- **First-aider approach:** be a designated, trusted point of contact.
- **Initial support:** Listen if someone shares concerns about gambling-related harm.
- **Brief chat & signpost:** Have a short conversation and direct them to professional support services.
